Introduction:

- Who remembers what melody is?
- When we played songs, what did you hear besides the melody?

Lesson:

- Use karaoke tracks to hear just the non-melody parts
- Song Examples

- Harmony in popular songs
 - o How many people do you hear singing?
 - Example: Say Something, Little Talks
 - Raise your hand when you hear the harmony
- Major / Minor chords
 - Do these make you feel happy or sad?
 - Compared to a single note, chords help express emotion
 - Activity: Lia plays major and minor chords, kids go to left side of the room when they feel happy, go to the right side when they feel sad
- Comparisons: melody is like the frosting and the background is the layers of cake, melody is like the centerpiece of a painting and the background is the supporting detail
